



Getting to thetamarind is very easy, especially from the New Bangkok International Airport which is just 90 minutes drive away. From the airport exit road, drive south on the Motorway (Route 7) for approximately 115 km until this modern toll road intersects with Route 36. Turn left (East) on Route 36 until you reach Route 331 (12.3 km), but continue straight under the overpass and make the next U-Turn (1.2 km) in order to come back to Route 331, where you will then bear to the left (South) heading towards Sattahip. Continue South on Route 331 until you reach the T-section marked "Silverlake Resort" (17.7 km) and turn right. This road winds through a scenic national park until it opens onto "Silverlake Resort," and then passes "Buddha Mountain on your left (8.4 km) until the road intersects with Sukhumvit Highway (12.5 km) Turn left (South) and drive along Sukhumvit Highway towards Sattahip until you reach the Bangsaray Village T-section (15.2 km on your right), but continue straight ahead past this until you reach a T-section on your left (800 meters) with the sign "Buraran," where you turn left, following the signs to Buraran, and then finally (700 meters) turn right and follow the road to the main entrance of Buraran, where security will direct you to the thetamarind.

For people coming from Pattaya (or U-Tapao Airport), take Sukhumvit Highway and drive towards the Bangsaray Village T-section (22 km from Pattaya heading south or 35 km from U-Tapao heading north), turning east at the T-section with the Buraran sign leading into the development as described above.
